Regarding: American citizen Mario Herrera-Padron, 270263-3535

The above-mentioned American citizen Mario Herrera-Padron has made an application to the embassy concerning his arrest on **November 1, 2006**. I understand that Mr. Herrera-Padron is now indicted for threat of violence against police officials, but Mr. Herrera-Padron has not been able to explain to the embassy, why the police at first was called and exactly what he was charged with, when he was arrested.

From the police's letter to Herrera-Padron it appears that his threats of violence should have been stated AFTER the arrest. The letter gives no explanation WHY Mr. Herrera-Padron was arrested or what he is in connection to this was charged for.

While the embassy must report arrest of American citizens to the foreign department in Washington, I thank in advance for a short update on the case.
